## What is the P & C?

It is a forum for parents, guardians and citizens to support and assist the government school system for the benefit of all students.

The P & C body has many functions:

- Encourage parents to contribute to the school's development;
- Develop parent participation and involvement in the school;
- A forum for the discussion of issues pertaining to the school and the community;
- Promote and support co-operation and communication of educational matters in the wider community;
- Assist the school with extra amenities for the benefit of all students; and
- Volunteer parents can join subcommittees in several areas: school uniform sales, fundraising, swimming and athletics carnivals, representation on the school board.

Through the interest of parents like you, the Corrigin District High School P & C has contributed significantly to the school. Contributions range from assistance with classroom items to the donation of graduation prizes and presentation night awards.

## P & C Structure

The Corrigin District High School P & C consists of the following office bearer positions: President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary. The Executive Committee consists of these office bearers, the School Principal and not less than two other financial members. All office bearer positions are declared vacant each year at the AGM. Anyone is welcome to nominate.

Office Bearer Positions:

**President:** is the vital link between the parent body and the school, developing and nurturing a good working relationship with the school administration. The main role of the President is to chair the P & C meetings and be the public face of the P & C.

**Vice President:** in the event that the President is absent at General Meetings, the Vice-President chairs. In addition, the Vice-President is ideally placed to act as a liaison person between the P & C and WACSSO.

**Secretary:**

- Records minutes of General and Executive Committee meetings;
- Maintains a register of financial and ex-officio members;
- Circulates incoming and outgoing correspondence as appropriate;
- Provides notable P & C items to the school newsletter;
- Retains custody of all documents relevant to the administrative activities of the P & C.

**Treasurer:**

- Responsible for all monies received and expended on behalf of the P & C, including uniform store and fundraising;
- Prepares and presents a report for every General Meeting;
- Prepares books for audit;
- Overall responsibility for all P & C accounts.

WACSSO (WA Council of State School Organisations) is the peak body representing parents of public school children in Western Australia. General P & C training can be provided by WACSSO covering the above roles and other information.

# How to get involved

The following lists specific ways parents can be involved and support their child/s education. Contact is regularly made via email, newsletters and the P & C Facebook page for various opportunities to support throughout the year.

There are many ways to be involved. We urge you to discover what your area of support is and join us, your P & C, in building a stronger community for our children, and future generations, who are fortunate to be able to say they are members of the CDHS Community.

- **Become a P & C financial member**

Our P & C comprises of parents and guardians of children attending our school, staff and other community members over the age of 18 years, who have paid an annual membership fee of \$1.00. This membership fee entitles you to the right to vote on all motions throughout the year when attending meetings. This membership also covers you under our insurance to assist at Sports days and with other fundraising activities.

We aim to have parents from all year groups as P & C members to ensure our meetings run with the interests of the entire school community.

- **Become a P & C Office Bearer**

- **Attend Meetings**

Presently the P & C meets in the third week of each Term, meeting in the library or other available room. Our AGM and election of office bearers is held prior to the first meeting of the school year. The AGM will be on Monday 16 February 2026 .

- **Fundraising**

The P & C offers a variety of fundraising opportunities throughout the year including but not limited to the following (which are open to change throughout the year):

- Community Events
- Catering
- Political Sausage Sizzles & Cakes at Election events

The above-mentioned activities are only possible through the generous donation of time from the parent volunteers within our school. Funds from these events and others are invested back into the school. We encourage parents to come along to any meetings to see how to help out and as a social occasion to have a chat.

- **Uniform Co-ordinator/s**
