

Student Motor Vehicle Policy

Policy Statement

Student use of vehicles at Corrigin District High School is a privilege, not a right. If students have a driver's licence, they may bring a vehicle on site to assist with daily travel to and from the school. Students need to seek written permission before a motor vehicle is to be brought onto school grounds, using the attached form. The attached form must be signed by student, parent and school principal and be on file in the administration office. Students who are out of good standing will forfeit the privilege of having their vehicle at the school for a pre-determined period of time. This will be a minimum of two school weeks.

Permission Form

In signing this policy, both the student and parent/guardian agree to adhere to the following:

1. Vehicles are to be driven by the student for the purpose of daily transport to and from the school.
2. All student vehicles are to be parked in the student car bay, unless otherwise advised by the Principal.
3. Any student who abuses the privilege of having a vehicle at school by breaching this policy or by reckless driving in or around school grounds, will lose the right to have their vehicle at school.
4. Student vehicles may be used during the school day if approved by the Principal or Deputy Principal.
5. If passengers are to be transported in a student vehicle, parent authorisation is also required.
6. Only the student authorised to bring the vehicle to the school can drive the vehicle.
7. Vehicles must be driven at all times with consideration for other road users, in a responsible manner and within the assigned speed limits.
8. Students who are out of good standing will forfeit the privilege of having their vehicle at school for a pre-determined period of time. This will be a minimum of two school weeks.
9. The Principal will use discretionary powers where it is considered necessary, to amend the vehicle policy.
10. Student cars may be searched by senior staff at the discretion of the Principal.
11. All care will be taken of student vehicles, but the school cannot accept any responsibility for damage done to any vehicle whilst on site. It is the responsibility of the student or their parent/guardian to make sure the vehicle is adequately insured.
12. Observe at all times a 20 km per hour speed maximum limit while driving into and out of the school.
